# Spring Salon

LCC will hold its annual Spring Salon on Monday May 8. The salon is a special competition night. The results of the salon are not part of the regular competition of the season and do not figure into the results for the year. Separate prizes are awarded for the salon competition.

## Eligibility

Prior use of a slide or print does not affect its eligibility in the Salon, except:

1. Former May Salon images which have received an award in a Lombard May Salon may not be re-entered in any format or category in subsequent Lombard Salons, and
2. Entries for Slide and Print of the Year must have scored at least 23 or won an award in regular competition during the current competition year.

Otherwise, Salon entries do not have to have been previously entered in club competitions. Print sizes and mounting requirements are the same as for our monthly competitions.

This competition is open to all members.

The standard categories of competition for the salon are listed in the large table. Additional categories will be revealed soon. If any additional category fails to get at least three competitors, there will be no competition for that category. All members are encouraged to compete in as many of the categories as they want. One entry is allowed per category
